DeMolay is much more than bi-weekly meetings and presentation of our public and private ceremonies. It is a program of service, social, and athletic events with the aim of developing the leadership skills of our members through planning and executing activities which interest the Chapter's membership.

The Chapter Recognition program has been designed to recognize the Chapters in Illinois DeMolay that has worked to elevate their Chapter program to be the best, well rounded Chapter in Illinois DeMolay.

The Recognition Program is designated in two levels:

- **Chapter of Excellence:** This first step provides criteria for annual and term planning that recognizes excellence in delivering the DeMolay program.
- **Chapter of the Year:** This competition among Illinois DeMolay Chapters will seek out and identify the one Chapter who excels beyond all others. To be considered for the Chapter of the Year, a Chapter must first qualify as a Chapter of Excellence.

The goals of the Chapter Recognition Program will be measured from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 with recognitions being made at the annual Illinois DeMolay Conclave.

Every Chapter is expected to work toward becoming a Chapter of Excellence and compete for Chapter of the Year. The winners will be our members as they will have active DeMolay activities and see they are part of the Premier Youth Program in America, DEMOLAY!

Illinois DeMolay Chapter of Excellence

The Illinois DeMolay Chapter of Excellence is built around the following seven (7) criteria:

- 1) Term Planning
- 2) Membership
- 3) Degrees/Ritual
- 4) Activities
- 5) Communication
- 6) State Events
- 7) Advisory Council

Term Planning

Chapters must submit to the Executive Officer Chapter no less than two (2) term plans per year. These must be post marked within 10 days of the Chapter's Installation of Officers.

The term plan should include, but not limited to:

Installation of Officers

Stated Meetings

State Events

Bi-weekly activities (must include at least 2 of the following)

- Social
- Civic Service
- Fund Raising
- Masonic Service
- Athletics

DeMolay Holidays (Obligatory Days, DeMolay Month)

Membership

New Member Growth:

Chapters qualifying as a Chapter of Excellence are required to achieve 18 points in membership growth from July 1 to June 30 of the current year. Points are per the guidelines of the Past Master Councilor Meritorious Service Award.

3 points for each new member 12-14 years of age

2 points for each new member 15-20 years of age

Degrees / Ritual:

Chapters must Obligate candidates on both the Initiatory & DeMolay Degree at least once during each of (2) terms between July 1-June 30 of the current program year. The Master Councilor presiding over the obligating of the candidate must recite the obligation from memory (not reading from the ritual).

Activities:

All DeMolay Obligatory Days must be observed. Only ONE Obligatory Day per term may be observed during a Stated Business Meeting. For terms which include March, a DeMolay Month program must be included.

Chapters must plan and execute an event to raise funds to be donated to the Kanes for Kiddies program.

Chapters are to plan and carry out at least two (2) activities in each of the following areas during the program year:

- Social
- Civic Service
- Fund Raising
- Masonic Service
- Athletics

(You may not use State events to cover a category. For example, Basketball Weekend cannot be counted as the athletic activity but Chapter basketball practices will satisfy as an athletic activity.) In addition to stated/special meetings, a Chapter qualifying as a Chapter of Excellence must include at least two DeMolay activities per month which may include obligatory days and state events.)

Communications:

Chapters are to distribute a Chapter newsletter which is authored primarily by Chapter members. The newsletter must be issued at least every other month to the Chapter Membership.

A Chapter **MUST** schedule a time, and show, at least one vignette of the Youth Protection video twice during the year (during different terms of office). Note the date/location and which section you will be showing on the Term Plan and document in the Chapter's stated meeting minutes.

State Events

Chapters must send members (non-State Officers or staff) to attend at least 4 of the following 5 Illinois DeMolay events:

- FallFest
- Basketball Weekend
- Sports Rally
- Conclave
- Basic Training or IDU

Chapters qualifying as a Chapter of Excellence are required to participate in at least 1 athletic competition or 1 team or individual ritual competitions at Illinois DeMolay FallFest.

Advisory Council

Chapters must submit all reports (ACR's, Form 10, Insurance Premiums, Chapter Financial Report, 990N (E-Postcard) Tax forms) on time to Illinois DeMolay.

Chapters must register two (2) new Advisors to the Advisory Council or hold an Advisor recruitment event.

Submission and Review

Chapter of Excellence criteria will be evaluated from July 1, 2010-June 30, 2011 of the current program year. Completed forms are due to the Executive Officer by July 7, 2011.

Illinois DeMolay Chapter of the Year

The Chapter accumulating the most points from July 1 to June 30 of the current program year will be designated the Illinois DeMolay Chapter of the Year.

Chapter of the Year will only be awarded to the one winning chapter. No runner up, 3rd and 4th place awards will be presented.

To qualify for Chapter of the Year, a Chapter must have met the minimum criteria for Chapter of Excellence.

The points shall be accrued as follows:

PART 1 – Membership Growth

- 30 points per new member ages 12-14 from July 1 to June 30
- 15 Points per new member ages 15-20 from July 1 to June 30
- 10 Point BONUS per member initiated over previous year total

PART 2 – Awards

- PMC - MSA First Letter (submitted within 10 days of installation) – 25 pts
- PMC - MSA Final Letter (submitted within 10 days of outgoing installation) – 25 pts
- PMC - MSA – (awarded) 75 pts
- Representative DeMolay (awarded) – 50 pts
- Illinois DeMolay Grand Ritualist Award – 50 pts
- Illinois DeMolay Junior, Senior, and Master Ritualist Award – 50 pts
- Illinois DeMolay Heritage Award (awarded) – 10 pts
- LCC - 5 points per person per lesson. (*Limit of 5 lessons per DeMolay, Sweetheart, Sweetheart Court, Advisor per year.*)
- Lamp of Knowledge – 10 points for each person earning

PART 3 – Communications

- Chapter Web presence (Website, Facebook, etc.) - 100 Pts
- Chapter Newsletter (authored primarily by chapter members) – 10 pts. per issue (Limit 1 per month or 120 pts.)

PART 4 – Chapter Operations & Activities

- Chapter Term Plan submitted to members, advisors, and Executive Officer – 100 pts per term (200 pts. max)
- Chapter develops and receives Advisory Council approval for a term budget for each term and submits to Executive Officer – 100 pts per term (200 pts max)
- Chapter establishes the 5 Standing Committees. No single DeMolay may chair more than one committee and Master Councilors may not chair any committee and committees must be 1 member or more. (10 pts for each committee. Bonus 20 pts if all five standing committees are assigned.)
- Submit Chapter activities to State Website calendar at least 60 days prior to event – 10 pts per item (60 Pts. Max)
- Follow and submit for the DeMolay Month Outstanding Chapter Award (Form submitted to DeMolay International, copy to the Executive Officer) (100 Pts.)
- Advisor Recruitment – 25 pts per new Advisor (75 Pts max)

PART 5 – State Activity Participation

Attendance at State Weekends (5 pts per DeMolay/Sweetheart/Sweetheart Court member per event. Limit of 50 points per event.)

Events include:

- Basic Training and/or IDU (combined attendance)
- Basketball Weekend
- Sports Rally
- Brotherhood Weekend
- Conclave
- Six Flags Masonic Youth Day
- Fall Fest

Ritual Competition – Must achieve minimum score

Participate/qualify in an individual competition at FallFest – 5 pts per person

Participate/qualify in a team competition at FallFest – 10 pts per team

Max 100pts for individual and team competitions

Ritual Supremacy

- 1st Place 50 pts
- 2nd Place 30 pts
- 3rd Place 20 pts
- 4th Place 10 pts

Athletic Supremacy

- 1st Place 50 pts
- 2nd Place 30 pts
- 3rd Place 20 pts
- 4th Place 10 pts

Athletics

20 Pts per event (Events: Basketball Weekend, Dodgeball, SportsFest at Conclave. *Note: SportsFest only applies to Chapter team competition and contingent on the criteria below*).

- No duplication of players is allowed to qualify for points in this category.
- No composite teams allowed for points in this category.
- Only state sponsored athletic events are included

20 pts for competing in the DeMolay International Bowling Competition

20 pts for competing in the DeMolay Postal Rifle Match

PART 6 - Charity

To qualify for Illinois DeMolay Chapter of the Year, the Chapter must achieve the Kanes for Kiddies minimum financial goal. (*Goals are based on \$25 per "active" member as reported at Conclave plus total new members joined from Conclave up to October 20 of the program year*)

Kanes for Kiddies (November to January)

50 pts if minimum goal achieved (chapters must achieve and submit on time, the financial goal set based on active membership).

10 BONUS points will be awarded for every \$50 raised above your Chapter's financial goal for.

Charity Challenge (March)

10 BONUS points for every \$50 raised for the Illinois DeMolay State Charity Challenge (held in March)

Submission and Review

Chapter of the Year Form must be submitted (postmarked) to the Executive Officer by July 7, 2011 after the program year concludes.
