

Other Awards

- **Life Saving Medal:** Presented for saving a human life.
- **Medal of Heroism:** For performing an act of Heroism in which the DeMolay was in danger of losing his own life.
- **Illinois DeMolay Legion of Merit:** For diligent and determination in participating in State and Chapter activities
- **Illinois DeMolay Ambassador Award:** For achieving various DeMolay Awards including the Representative DeMolay, Past Master Councilor's Meritorious Service Award, Lamp of Knowledge, Blue Honor Key and Grand Ritualist Award. DeMolay's must have earned 4 of 5 of those awards.

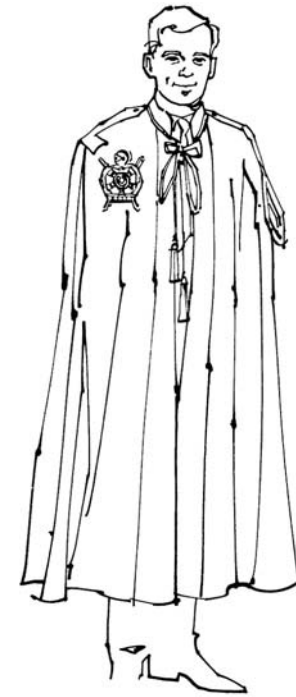
Honors



- **The Degree of Chevalier:** The highest honor DeMolay International can bestow on an Active or Senior DeMolay for outstanding service and activity to DeMolay. Nominees must be at least 17 years of age and been a member in good standing. Nominees may not know they have been nominated.

Other Honors

- **DeMolay of the Year:** Presented annually at Illinois DeMolay Conclave for a member who has exemplified the ideals of DeMolay. One person per year receives award.



Honors and Awards For Active DeMolay Members



An **AWARD** is an achievement to be worked toward, a goal or a recognition to be earned. You can apply for an award

An **HONOR** is granted without the recipient knowing about it until it is announced. DeMolay honors must be voted on by the International Supreme Council of DeMolay International.

MEMBERSHIP AWARDS



- **#1 Pin:** Awarded to members who recruits one member to join the Chapter.
- **PETITIONS Merit Bar:** Awarded for increments of 3 new members recruited to join the Chapter (White Merit Bar for 3 members, Gold Merit Bar for 15)
- **Founder's Membership Award:** Awarded for recruiting five new members to join the Chapter.
- **Blue Honor Key:** Awarded for recruiting ten new members to join the Chapter. (Stars will be added to the blue honor key for each multiple of 10 new members recruited to join the Chapter.)

SELF ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS



- **Leadership Correspondence Course:** A series of 5 open book questions about DeMolay International using the DeMolay Leaders resource Guide and the “HI DAD” book of the life of Frank S. Land (DeMolay’s Founder). Each successfully passed course earns the Correspondence Course Merit Bar. Completion of all five earn the Lamp of Knowledge award.
- **Representative DeMolay Award:** The highest self assessment award for members. DeMolays rate themselves in living up to the seven DeMolay virtues and review their ratings with their “RD Advisor”. A DeMolay must have a minimum of 6 months membership prior to completing this award.
- **Past Master Councilor’s Meritorious Service Award:** An award for Master Councilors (the Chapter’s President) recognizing his accomplishments during his term. The Term must include a well balanced program, growth in membership, commitment to giving the ritual from memory and confer the initiation once during his term.
- **Merit Bars:** Recognition for DeMolays for achievement in some phase of Chapter Activity. Five color groups indicate the number of times the bar is earned (1st = White, 2nd = Red, 3rd = Blue, 4th = Purple and 5th = Gold). Bars may be earned for Athletics, Attendance, Civic Service, Conclave, Fine Arts, Fund-Raising, Installing, Journalism, Correspondence Course, Masonic Attendance, Masonic Service, Membership, Merit, Priory participation, Religion, Scholastic, Visitation and Ritual.
